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Procedure of plant protection products registration from the point of view of assessing unit



Effect on vertebrates	National Institute of Public Health Bureau for Chemical Substances and Preparations
Phytotoxicity	Plant Protection Institute – National Research Institute University of Warmia and Mazury



The important issues and challenges

- Information flow among units
 (results of some assessment can facilitate preparation of the others, but problems with timing)
- The evaluation dossier (shape, details, volume, language)
- The diversity of assessed ppp (to much specialization not always pays)
- What in case of not sufficient doccumentation (the simplest way – negative assessment not in the farmers' interest; demanding additional data from producers – HUGE problems with timing)
