Legislation

Phytosanitary Act No. 193/2005

- **§ 3 General obligations**
 - (2) obligation
 - to keep records of consumption of PPPs (including application details)
 - to submit report to CCTI (Central Controlling and Testing Institute) by 1st December

Legislation

Regulation of MoA No. 183/2009

- Details of consumption evidence, form of application of PPS and reports
- Consumption evidence – 10 years
- Annual submission reports to CCTI
- Including PPPs for seed treatment

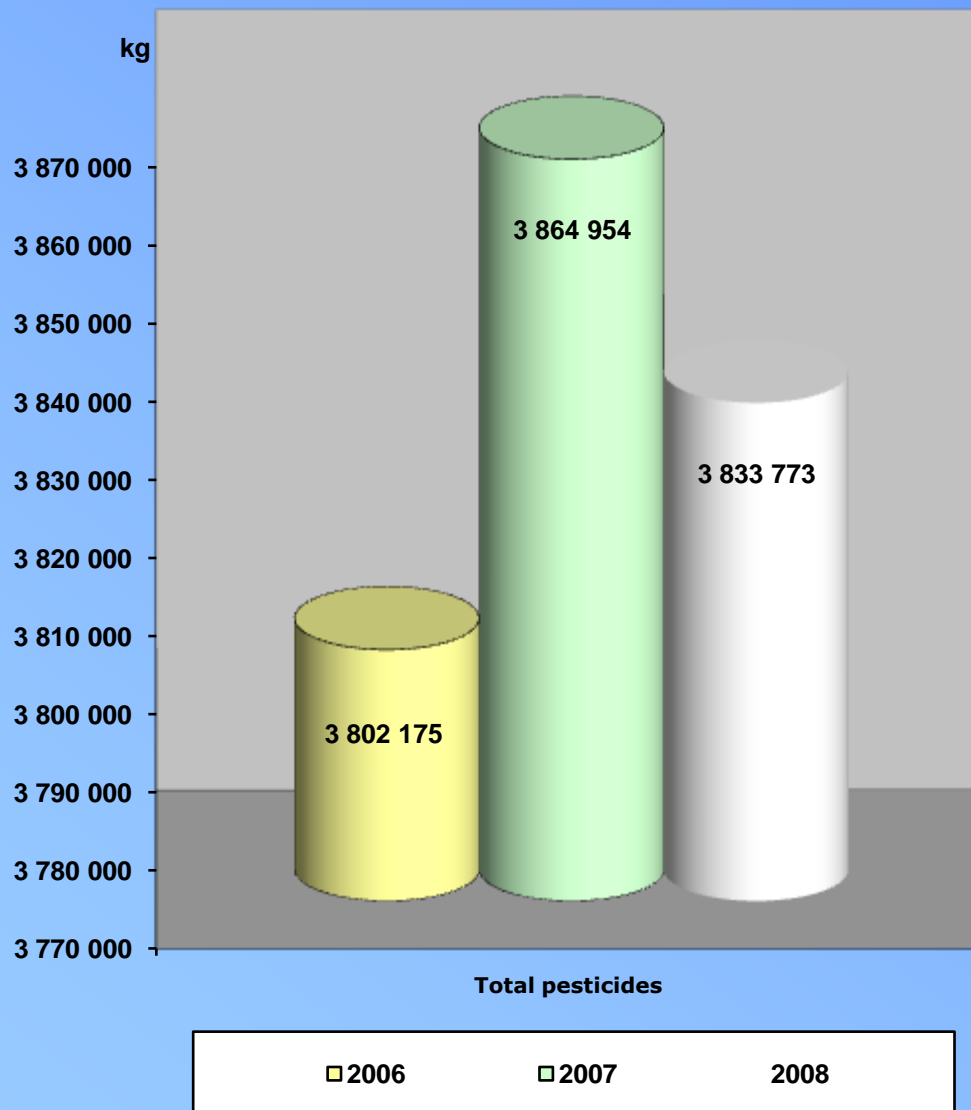

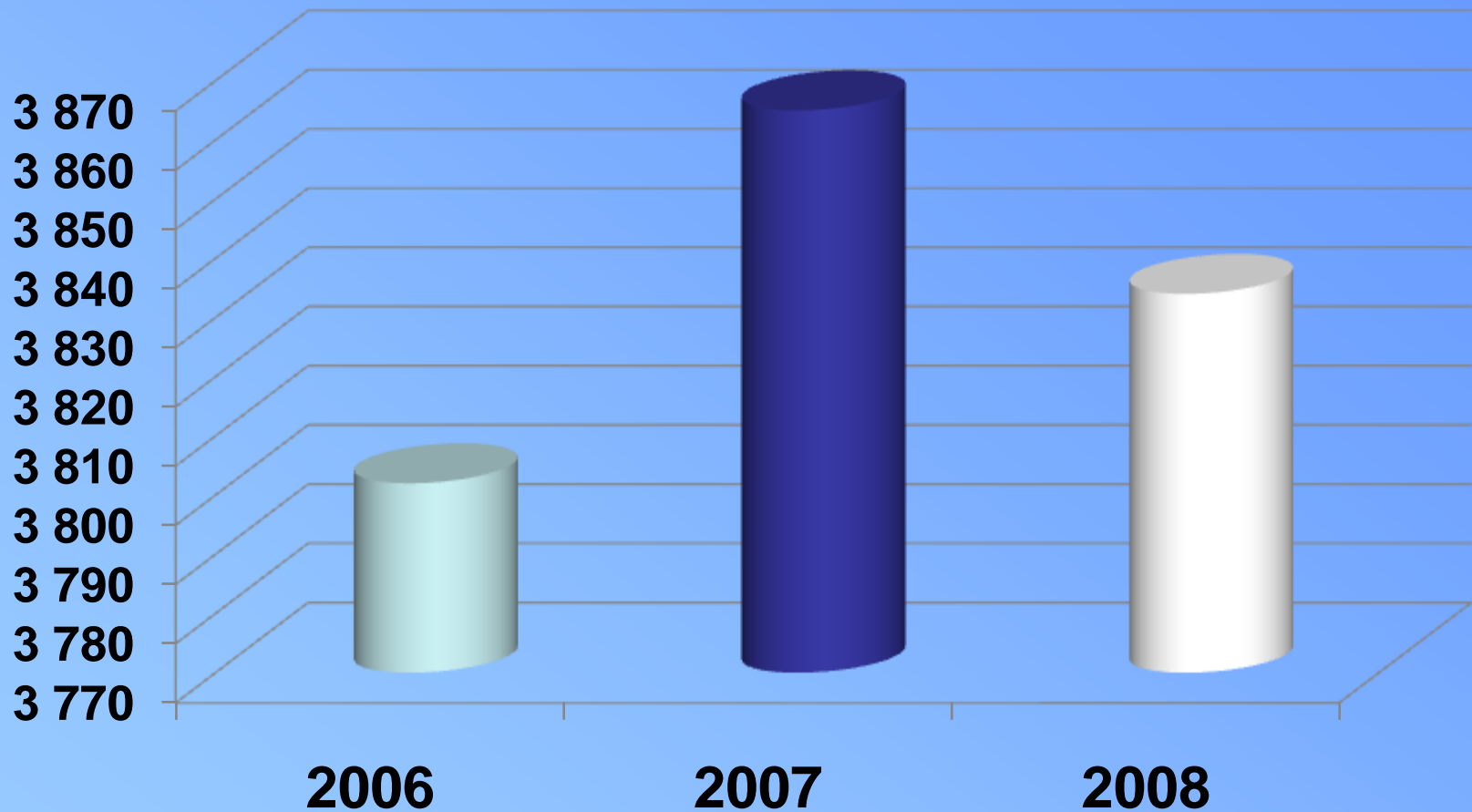

TOTAL CONSUMPTION OF PLANT PROTECTION PRODUCTS 2006 - 2008



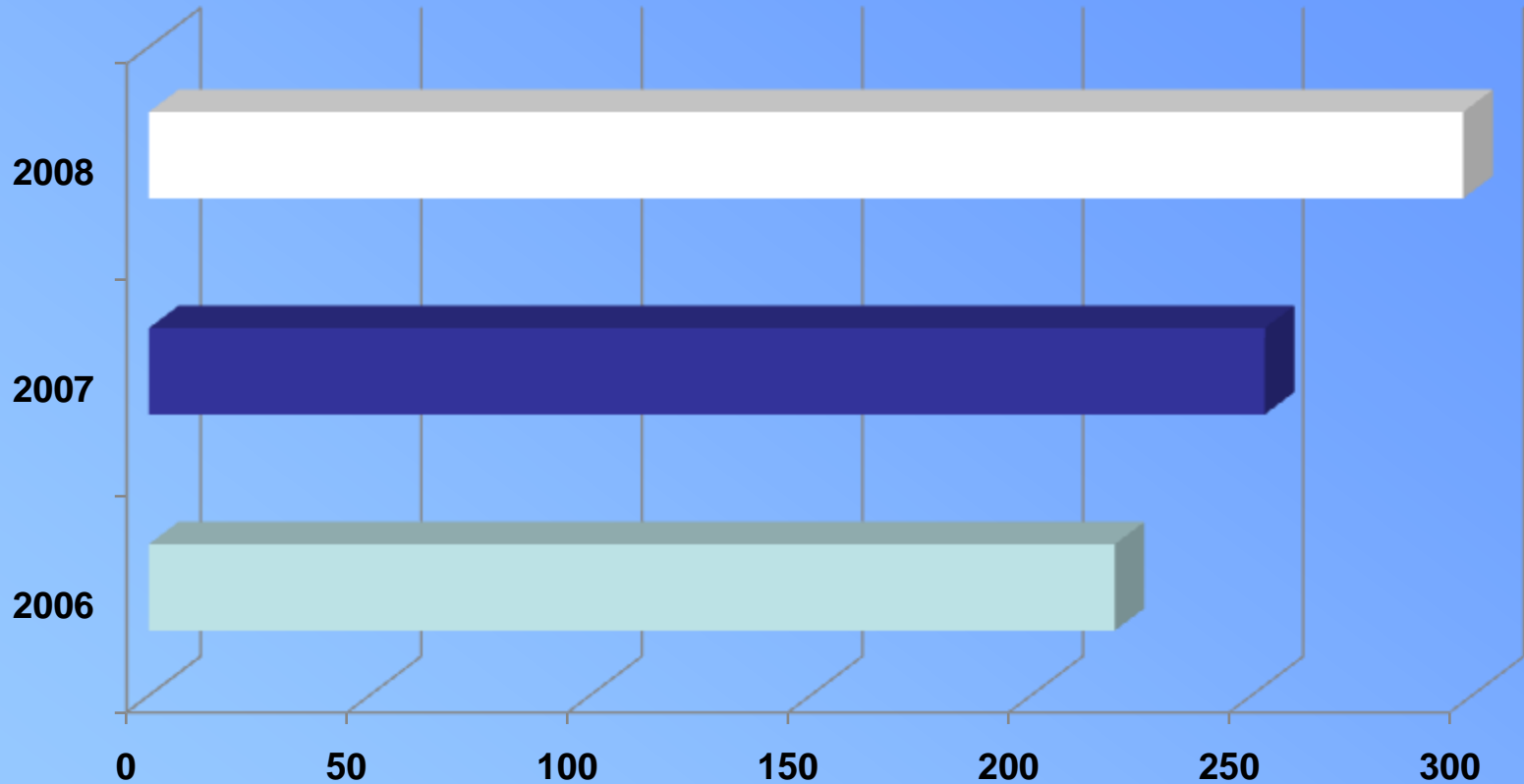

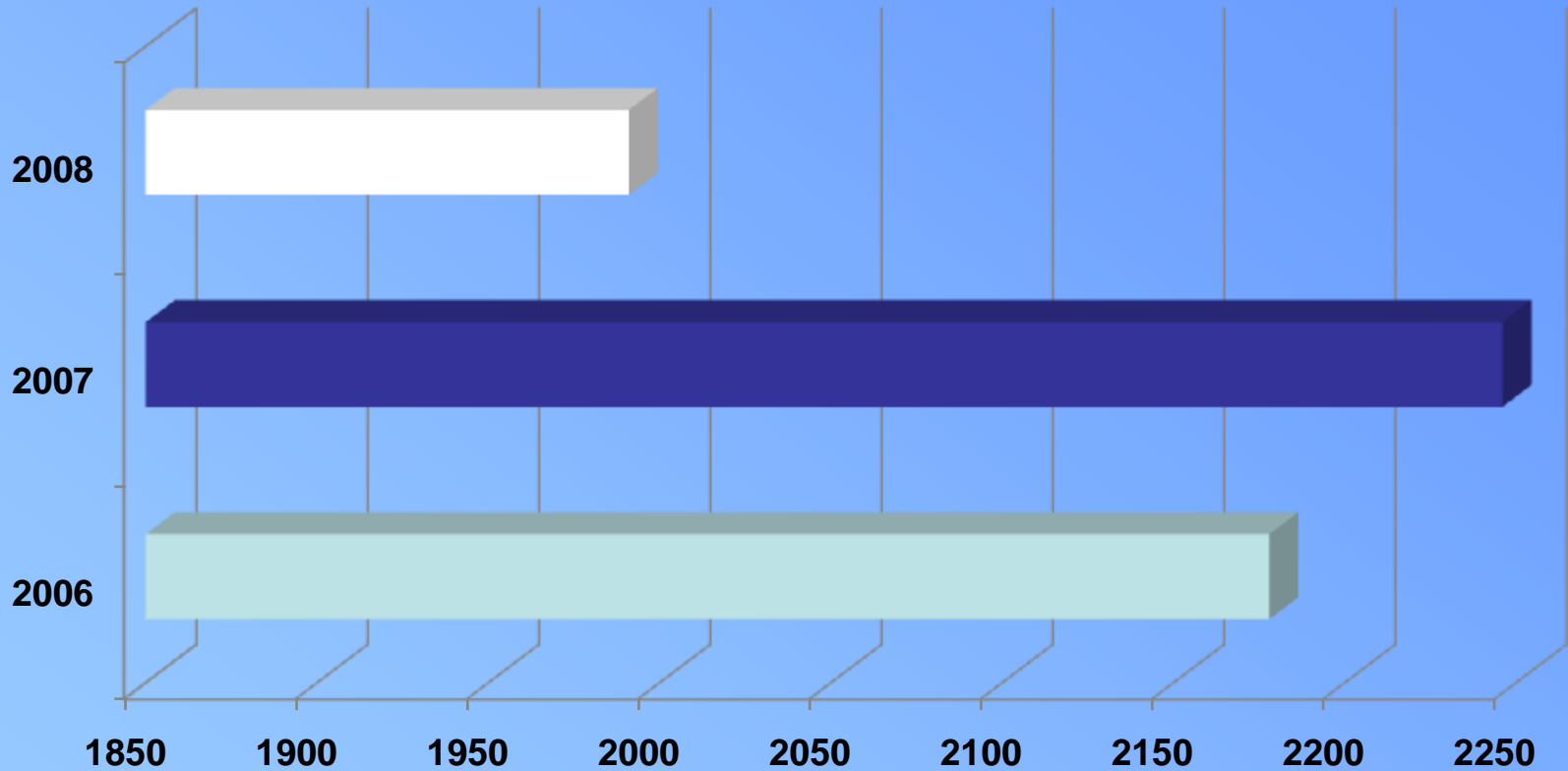

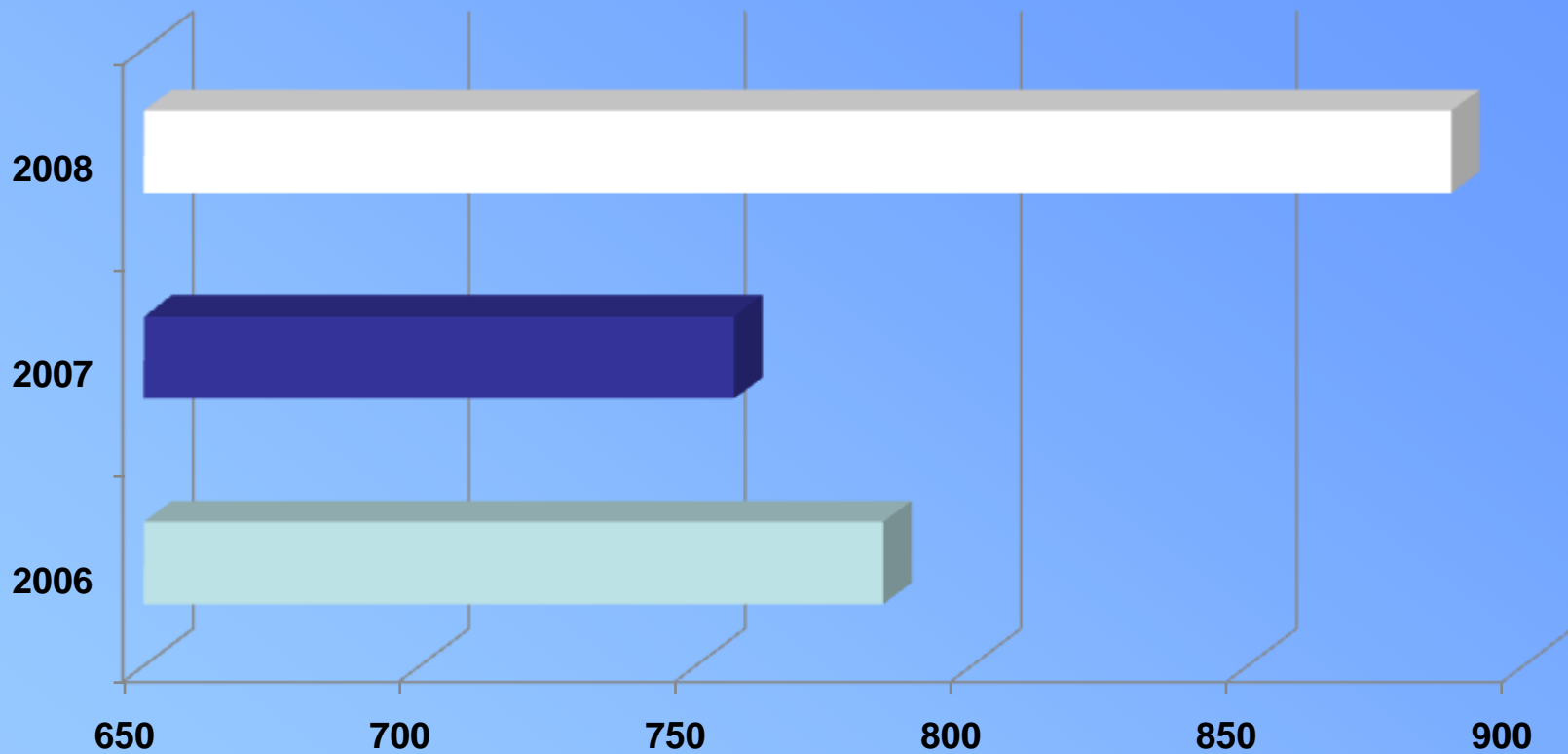

Herbicidas (t)



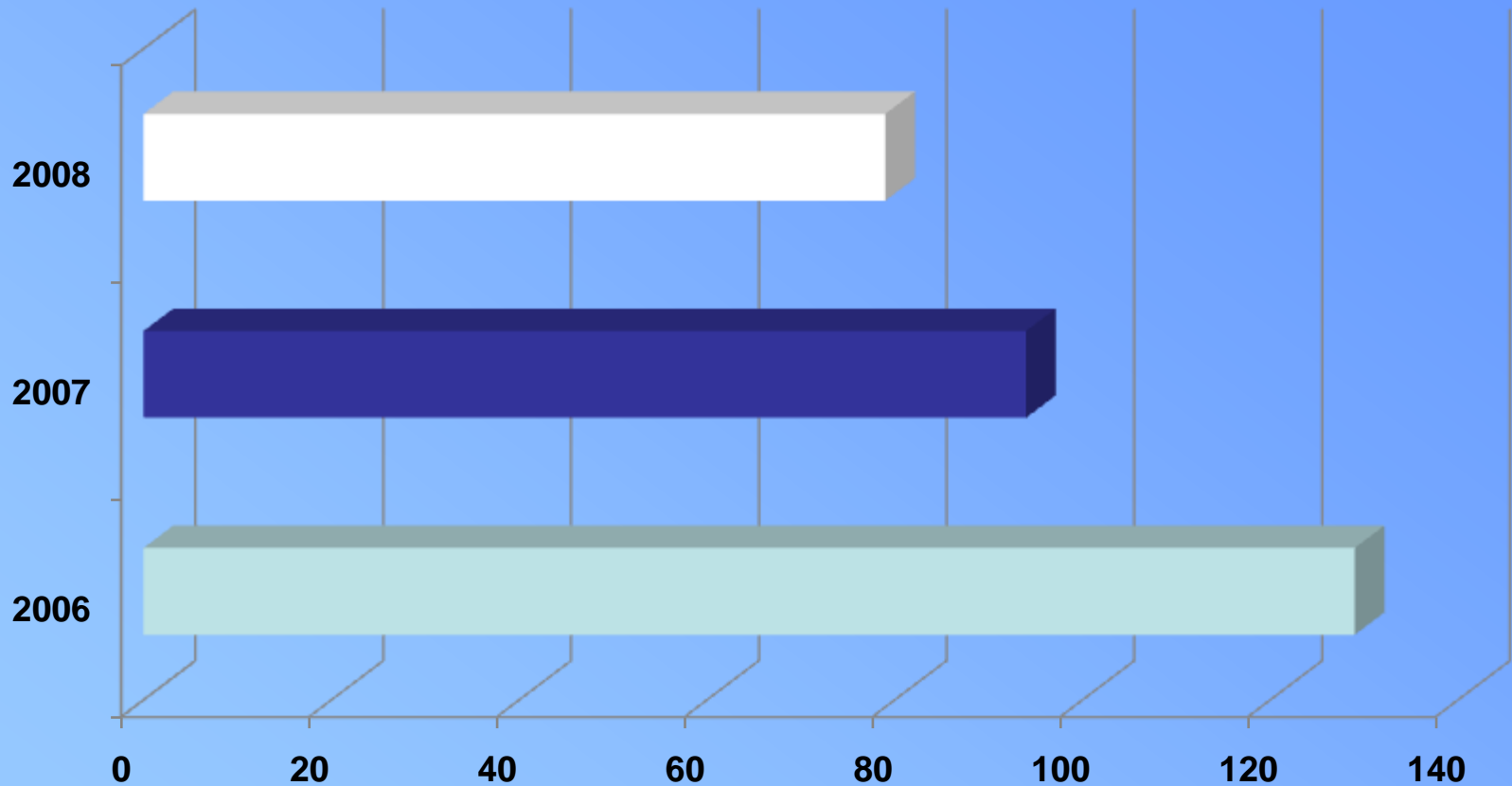

Fungicides and bactericides (t)



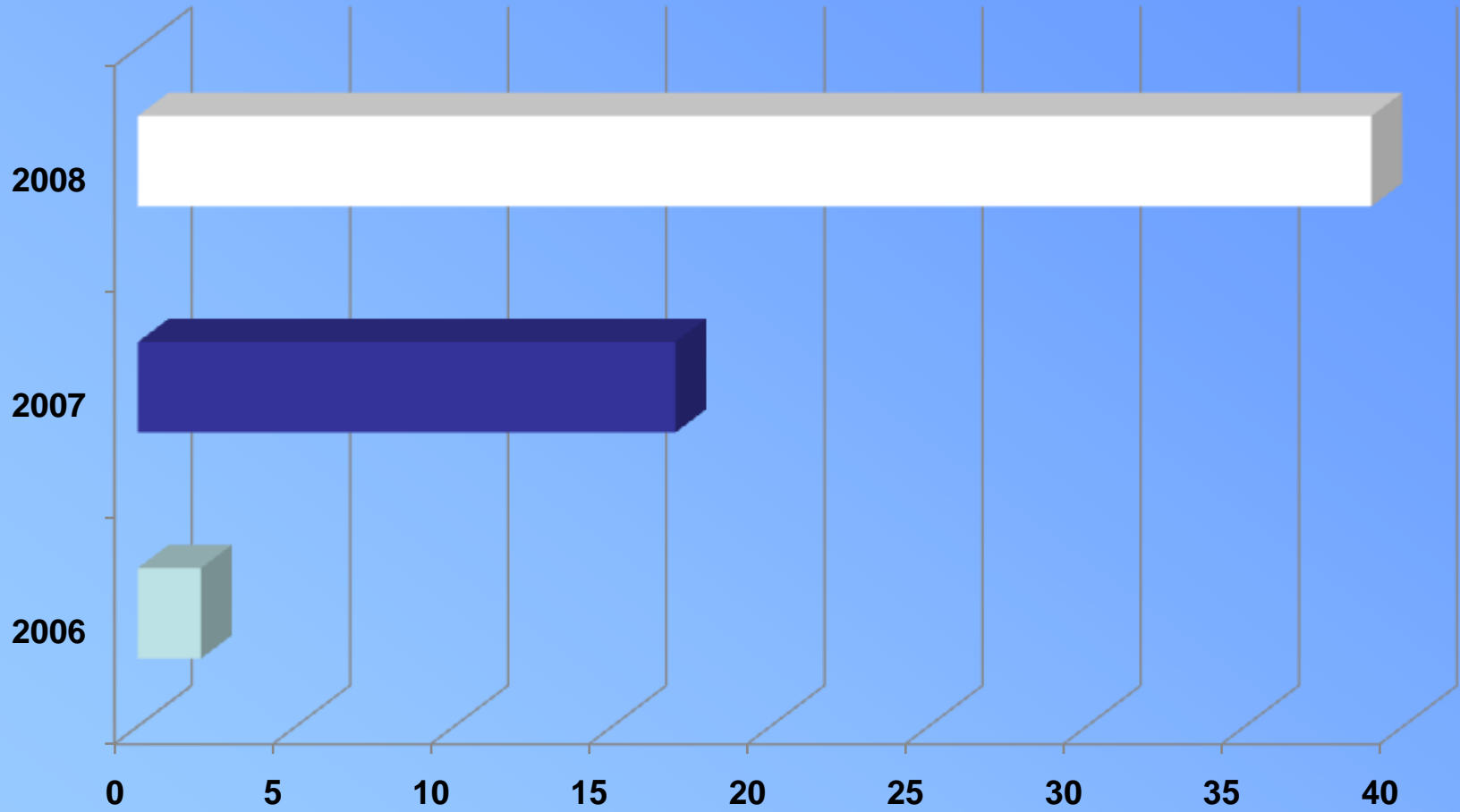

Seed treatments - fungicides (t)



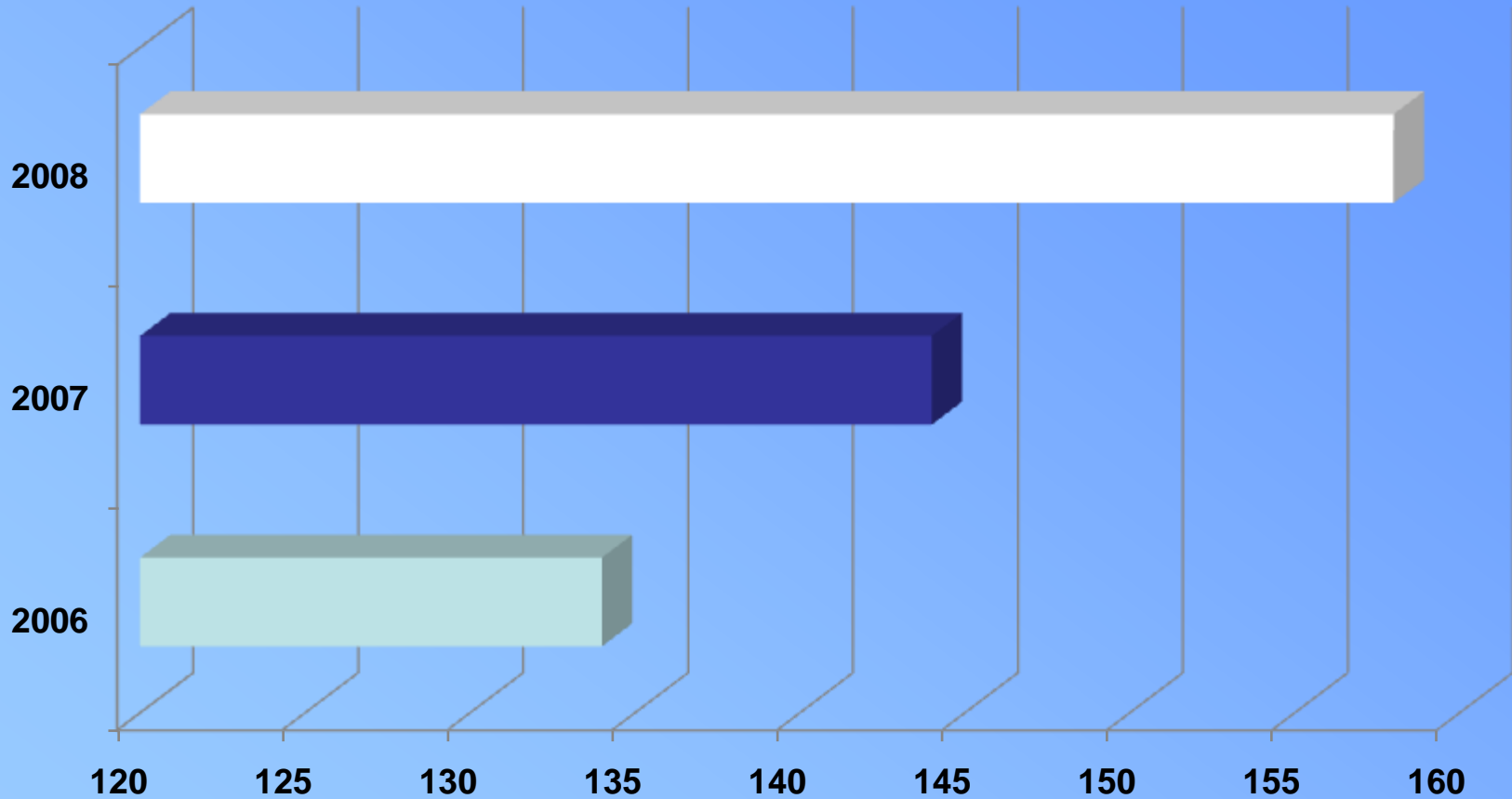

Seed treatments - insecticides (t)



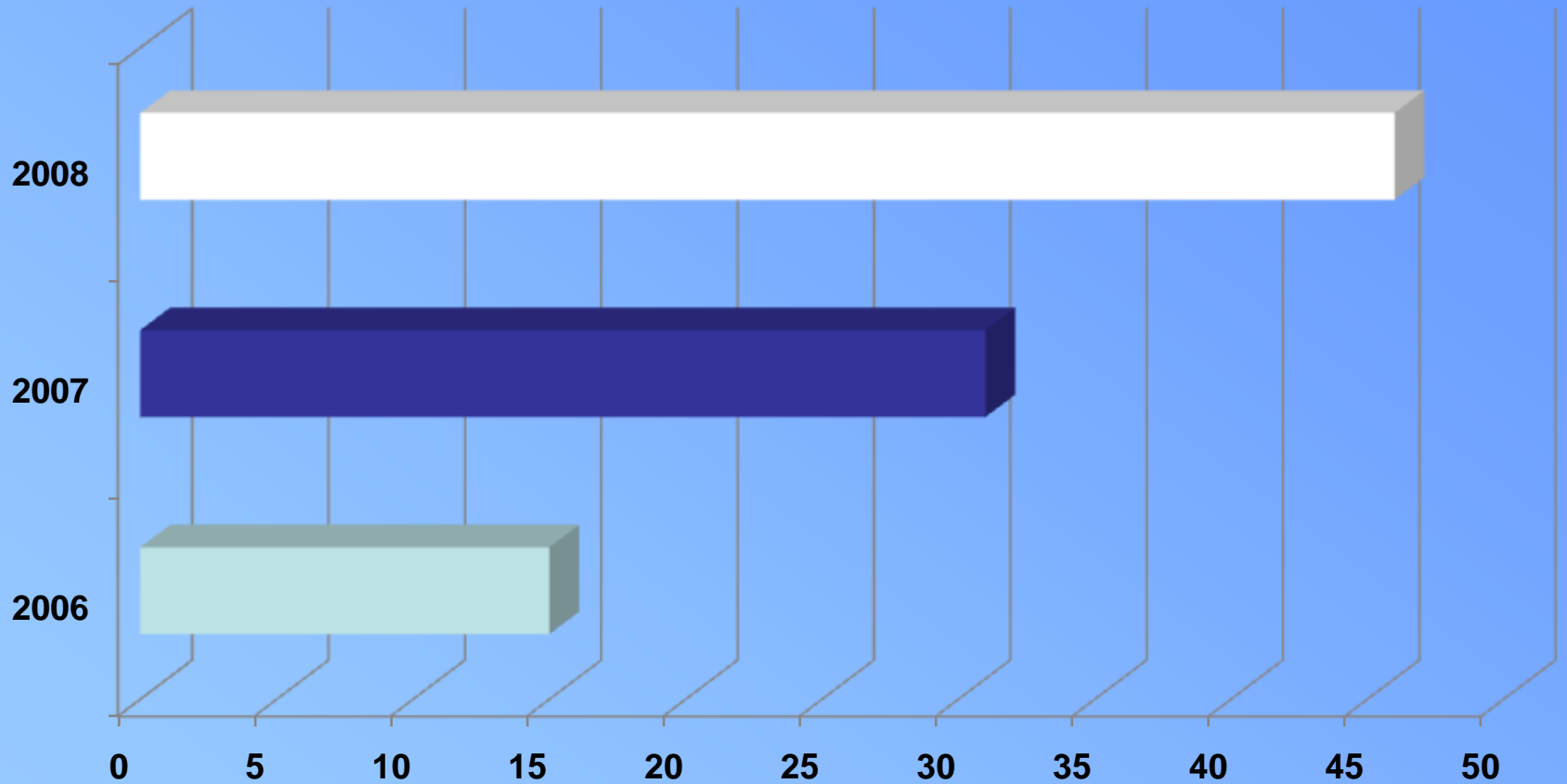

Plant growth regulators (t)



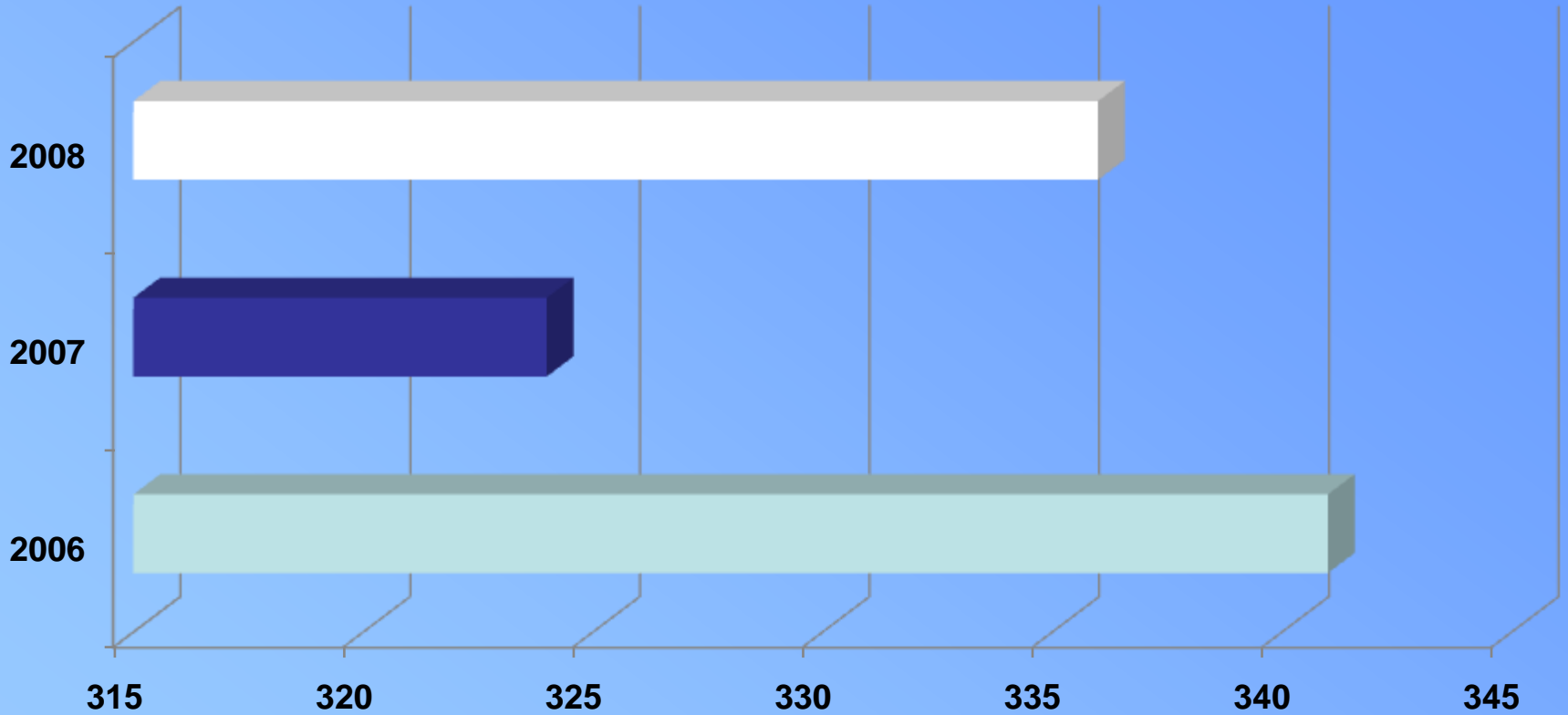

In 2008

increase

- Carbamates –insecticides
- Pyrethroides (insecticides, seed treatments)
- Triazols, diazols (fungicides)
- Benzimidazoles (seed treatments fungicides)
- Anti-coagulants (rodenticides)

In 2008

decrease

- Organo –phosphates (insecticides)
- Botanical products and biologicals (insecticides)
- Mineral oils
- Carbamates (herbicides)
- Dithiocarbamates (seed treatments – fungicides)
- Desiccantes
