New legal situation

- PPP Regulation basic text; not implemented, repeated or interpreted in national laws – direct application!
- Commission Regulations direct application!
- CZ Act and its Regulations legal texts of 3rd level establishing
 - Competences of individual authorities
 - National level processes (those not defined by PPP Regulations)
 - Optional points ("MS may")
 - Further national provisions (not data requirements!)



Legal interpretation

Present state:

- CZ Regulatory authority
- CZ Ministry
- CZ National courts
- Commission (interpretation of Directive)
- ECJ (interpretation of Directive)

From 2011:

- CZ + 26 Regulatory authorities
- CZ Ministry
- CZ + 26 National courts
- Commission
- ECJ court



State of play

- Draft amendment at the stage of interministerial consultations
- Adoption by the Parliament May 2011
- Presidential signature before 14 June 2011



Main new points in Act

Efficiency of PPP inspections

- Repackaging
 - Notifications to SPA in advance
 - Documentation and traceability
 - Transfer of the batch number and expiry date; approved package
- Distribution
 - Good distribution practice
 - Documentation and traceability



Main new points in Act

PPP Authorisations

- Better definition of minor uses
- Definition of cases of public interest
- Possibility of SPA initiative in cases of public interest + authorisation via SPA notice

Reduction of administrative upload for farmers



Changes in Organisation and Capacity

- Still under discussion
- Reduction of number of branches within PPP Section
- Strenghthening of post-registration area
- Specialisation of PPP inspectors
- National Food Safety Authority before 2013
- Seminars for applicants
- Better information of publics



Further concepts

biological efficacy

- Dossier should cover the Czech conditions
- Comparability will be taken into account during assessment or commenting
- Possible impact on the label or authorisation
- Minimum effective dose?
- Number of tests?
- Expert Group desirable
