#### What is declared?

- ...high level of protection of human and animal health and the environment (to safeguard the competitiveness of Community agriculture)...
- ...to increase the free movement of products and availability of products in the Member States...
- ...to avoid any duplication of work, to reduce the administrative burden for industry and for Member States and to provide for more harmonised availability of plant protection products...



### State of play

- Interpretation of many key provisions under discussion
- Some interpretations are contradictory with aims declared
- Problems with capacity and deadlines in some MS's
- Support to national regulatory structures and testing organisations by a part of national requirements
- Lack of trust in some areas



## **Biological Efficacy**

- Minimum effective dose
- Minimum number of trials and their location
- Definition of "conditions prevailing in zone"
- Comparable x Relevant
- National requirements x specific conditions
- Registration Report level of details



## **Biological Efficacy**

- Dossier should cover national conditions
- Relevance of data shall be taken into account during assessment or commenting
- Possible impact on the label or authorisation



### Czech Approach

- Reduction of duplications in the expert area by reduction of national requirements
- No divergence between mutual recognition and authorisation
- Voluntary initiative in mutual recognition will increase (reduction of emergency authorisations)



### Czech Approach

- Focusing on minor uses
- Better definition of cases of public interest
- Procedures in favour of plant protection and safety; not in favour of regulatory structures
