What is declared?

- ...high level of protection of human and animal health and the environment (to safeguard the competitiveness of Community agriculture)...
- ...to increase the free movement of products and availability of products in the Member States...
- ...to avoid any duplication of work, to reduce the administrative burden for industry and for Member States and to provide for more harmonised availability of plant protection products...



State of play

- Interpretation of many key provisions under discussion
- Some interpretations not fully in line with aims declared

However:

- Shorter deadlines, processes sped up
- Solutions for minor uses easier found
- Positive reactions from industry (e.g. harmonisation of formulations and uses)
- Harmonisation of dRR
- Intensive co-operation and communication



Organisation

- **Number of staff has not changed:**
 - 9 co-ordination, incl. parallel trade
 - 4 ecotox
 - 3 efate
 - 4 fys-chem
 - 6 efficacy, GEP, minor uses
 - 8 admin, management
 - 12 (cca) mam. tox, residues incl. biocides
- **Ministry of Agriculture – 4 persons involved in NAP, appellations, policies**



Organisation

- 2 institutions involved: SPA and NIPH
- From April 2012 a specific SW module for information exchange
- Sharing of electronic dossiers in Caddy format
- Sharing of electronic dRR and their parts
- Sharing of co-ordination instructions via SW



Workload

- **January – November 2012 high workload due to applications submitted before 14 June 2011**
- **Capacity estimate – up to 36 zonal applications /year**
- **From January 2013 more capacity for evaluation of active ingredients**



NAP

- Discussed 2010 - 2012 by Working Groups organised at the Ministry of Agriculture
- Approved by the government in September 2012
- Every half a year reporting, once a year a summary report to the government
- Ministry of Agriculture, Ministry of Health, Ministry of Environment



NAP

Main aims:

- Reduction of risks connected with the pesticide use
- Better use (optimisation) of plant protection products use without reduction of agricultural production and quality of plant products
