Mandate of FAO

- **Provision of Information** – collects, analyses, interprets, disseminates information and promotes networking
- **Advice** – FAO provides independent advice on agriculture and rural development policy and planning
- **Neutral Forum** – FAO offers a neutral forum for discussion and formulation of rural policies, negotiation of agreements and establishment of standards (e.g. Codex Alimentarius)
- **Development Assistance** – FAO provides practical help to member countries through technical assistance, training and capacity development

- Workshop on sustainable crop production and conservation agriculture
- Assessment studies for REU member countries for sustainable crop production



A02 Capacity enhanced for implementation of the International Plant Protection Convention (IPPC), use of Standards and Locust management in 2010

- Regional Workshops and Consultations on IPPC Implementation
- Regional Workshops on the review of draft International Standards for Phytosanitary Measures (ISPMs)
- Technical support for national and regional locust management



A03 Technical capacity enhanced for pesticide and obsolete pesticides management

- Capacity building for implementation of the RC, pesticide quality control, residue monitoring and obsolete pesticide management
- Support for pesticide quality control and residue monitoring
- Regional Workshop on awareness rising and implementation of Rotterdam Convention



A04 Capacity enhanced for improvement/development and implementation of seed programmes and better management of PGRFA

- Support for development of seed production systems through implementation of TCP and GCP projects.
- Support for development of national programme for plant genetic resources for food and agriculture
- Regional workshops on seed production and PGRFA



Types of Technical Assistance

- The FAO field programme is funded through two main sources of funds:
 - regular programme
 - Technical Cooperation Programme (TCP)
 - Special Programme for Food Security (SPFS)
 - extra budgetary resources received from multilateral and bilateral donors
 - Trust Fund Programme (TF)
 - Cooperative Programme with International Financial Institutions (e.g. TCI/WB)



Technical Cooperation Programme (TCP)

- TCP projects aim to fill in a **critical technical gap** by providing **technical inputs** (expert and consultant services; practically-oriented training; equipment and supplies, related to training)
- Provides **technical expertise** through **targeted, short-term, catalytic** TCP projects
- project value can be up to US\$500 000 and can last up to 24 months (exceptionally 36 months)



Trust Fund Programme (TF)

- Types of TF programmes:
 - The Government Cooperative Programme (GCP)
 - Unilateral Trust Funds (UTF)
 - Global Environment Facility (GEF)
 - UN Agencies (UNDP, UNEP)
 - Emergency Operations and Rehabilitation (TCE)
 - Consultant Trust Funds (CTF)
 - FAO Trust Fund for Food Security and Food Safety
 - Decentralized Cooperation Programme (DCP)
 - Associate Professional Officer Programme (APOs)
