D-PPPs responsibility

- drafts legislation in the area of PPPs
- coordinates the process of registration and re-registration of PPPs between applicants and evaluators (from submission of the dossier to issuance of the authorisation)

❖ carries out completeness check of application for registration of PPPs

❖ issues authorisations of PPPs

D-SUP responsibilities

- drafts legislation in the area of pesticide residues and sustainable use of pesticides
- prepares and coordinates programmes of post-authorisation control of PPPs (formulation monitoring)
- prepares and coordinates national monitoring programmes of pesticide residues in the products of plant origin
- maintains necessary evidences and registers relating to PPPs

Progress in the procedure of re - registration of PPPs since XVI CEUREG

According to the 1st programme of re-registration, dating from November 2007, the same deadline for submission of the dossier for Step 1 and 2 was set up!

Re-registration ...

Groups 1- 5

- ❑ **All unsupported authorizations of groups 1-5 are revoked to the January 1st 2013**
- ❑ **Grace period for sale of existing stocks is 18 months!**



Revision of the Programme of PPPs re-registration



The revised Programme started in April 2012

It comprise only Step 1, in order to provide that all PPPs are in compliance with the special provisions of the Commission implementing Regulations on approval of active substances

Current Status in October 2013

253 (from a total of 456)	109	144

203 unsupported PPPs were revoked on 1st July 2013!

Legislation activities, progress since last CEUREG XVI



Framework Directive (2009/128/EC): the Ordinance on establishment of the framework for the national action to achieve the sustainable use of pesticides was implemented in 2012.

The National Action Plan (NAP) to achieve sustainable use of pesticides adopted by the Government on June 14th 2013.

Act implementing the Regulation 1107/2009 and the Act implementing the Regulation 396/2005 adopted by the Parliament on June 21st 2013.

Other activities since last CEUREG XVI ...

New Phytosanitary Strategy for 2013-2016 was adopted by the Government in March 2013.

National requirements for registration of PPPs in Croatia (National addendum) is published on the MA Website!

- ❑ **New Act on Sustainable Use of Pesticides is in the drafting procedure - deadline 4th Quarter 2013**
- ❑ **New Ordinance on the fees for the authorisation of PPPs in the drafting procedure - deadline November 2013**
