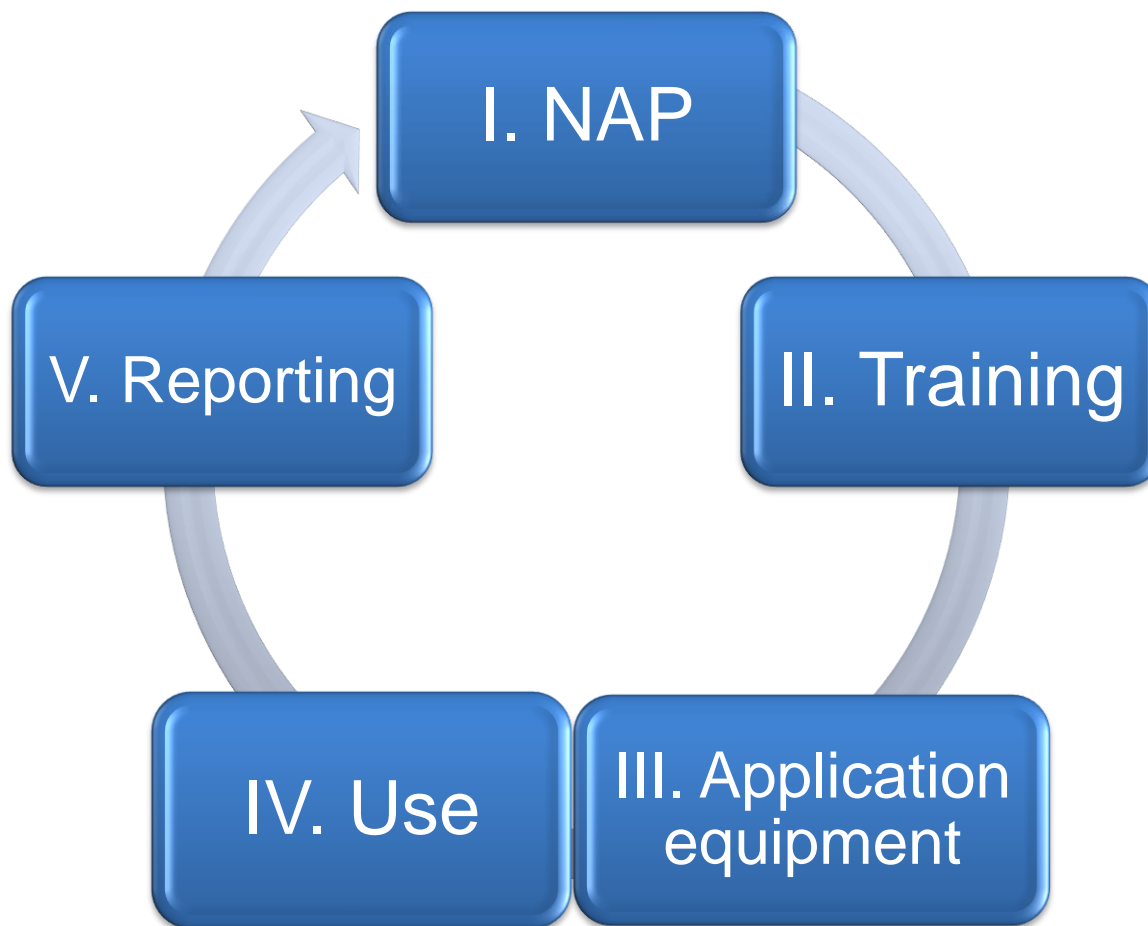

- Encourage alternative approaches.

National annual report - 1

- Not much more in training and information raising,
- Not much more in testing of sprayers (EU standards); aerial spraying banned,
- Poisoning cases gathering data started to build up.



National report - 2

- Low risk PPPs – lower fees for registration adopted,
- IPM – general principles adopted; to develop crop and sector specific GD,
- Improve advising and forecasting service,
- Drift and use on public areas – rules adopted.



National report - 3

- Rural development measures – financial support; use of less risky PPP for waters,
- Support / development of alternatives and new technological solutions.



National risk indicators

- Volume of sales and use,
- Frequency of use,
- Load index,
- No. of trainings,
- No. of sprayers tested,
- MRLs (food and water),
- No. eco farms,
- toxic vigilance.
