National action plan

- The National Plant Protection Action Plan was accepted by the **Plant Protection Committee** of the Ministry of Agriculture at its meeting on 26 November 2012.
- Most of the issues in the Sustainable Use Directive have always been part of the Hungarian plant protection thinking and practice.



Areal plant protection activity

- Is banned and derogation are only granted under strict condition
- In 2016, more than 85% of aerial spraying in the EU was accounted for by only two MS
- Aerial spraying has a long history of several decades in Hungary under strict legislation and conditions



Marketing, purchasing and using PPPs

- **Category I**

University degree specialised in plant protection

- **Category II**

Hungarian Chamber of Professionals and doctors of Plant Protection

- system of education with licence for product category II

- **Cat. II & III**

Regular training for products Category II and III

Revalidation of licence - regular training on 5 years basis

Supervision of wholesalers and retail trades supervised at least once a year



- **CSEBER** - Wastes Packing Material Recollection System
- Re-collection and handling of pesticides contaminated packaging wastes
- Campaign of the MoA



- **CSEBER** was founded in 2003
- The activity of CSEBER covers 96% of the Hungarian pesticide supplier market
- **CSEBER** recollects wastes of companies on a contract basis.



- 2017 - Ongoing revision - Plant Protection Committee
- No structural changes, but changes with regard to the following:
 - ❖ demonstrations farms network,
 - ❖ extension of IPM inspections,
 - ❖ electronic register of PPP sales,
 - ❖ refining indicators and quantitative targets
