Main domains of intervention by BNEVP in Phytosanitary field

- Misappropriation of use of PPPs
- Distribution of non-authorized PPPs
- Trade of illegal and counterfeited products:
- on a national scale
- on European and international scales
- Supervision of production, storage and marketing sectors

✤ Active Collaboration with Customs in Le Havre port since 2013.

Active Collaboration with colleagues from other European Countries (in the sea port of Hamburg, Antwerp, Rotterdam) but also in Poland, that has many European union entry points (land and sea).




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Tracing and tracking by the Hamburg's inspectors

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First step: documentary control

MINISTÈRE DE L'AGRICULTURE DE L'AGROALIMENTAIRE ET DE LA FORÈT Thanks to the information (Bill of loading) received from the Customs of Le HAVRE, we can continue our investigations: traceability and origin of AS, especially the manufacturer in China to know the sourcing in compliance with Regulation (EU) n° 544/2011 *implementing Regulation (EC) N° 1107/2009 as* regards the data requirements for active substances.







Second step:

MINISTÈRE DE L'AGRICULTURE DE L'AGROALIMENTAIRE ET DE LA FORÉT Request to the firm (buyer) concerning the origin of the AS used to formulate authorized PPPs:

- If AS is used to formulate PPP for another European country, this information is sent to this country.

- If AS is used to formulate PPP in France, we will verify the authorizations in France and the conformity of the origin of AS.

Question: What is the compatibility between:

the manufacturer identified in the business transaction and

the manufacturer (name and production site) declared to the French authority (ANSES), that delivered the authorization for the placing on the market of plant protection product?






Last step: check of conformity by ANSES

Result: The origin of Active sustance is in compliance with the origin that is declared at ANSES.

But if the origin is not in compliance, we continue the investigation to look for intelligence and start the implementation of legal proceedings.

Nowadays, following a piece of information from colleagues in 2016, a judicial proceeding is led by a prosecutor in Paris against a firm that has used a non-authorized AS from China to formulate a fungicide.
