Foundation of AGES and BAES – 2002




- Centralizing of all sub-organisations into one organisation ("One Stop Shop")
- Clear separation between
 Risk Assessement Risk Management
 - Institute for Plant Protection Products
 as part of the AGES-Division for Food Security
 (civil law organisation with 2 owners)
 Risk assessments and preparatory/administrative issues/activities
 - **Federal Office for Food Security**Authority in the first instance and risk manager in connection with product authorisation/registration, control measurements,...

Consequences





- Separation of Evaluation and Management Decision
- One Stop Shop
- + continuous competition with other Member States/ Authorities/Agencies concerning zonal Assessments
- Economic compulsions and instructions
 (AGES is a civil Law organisation; financial basis of the institute is based for the most part on fees)
- Public observation ("AGES is paid by Notifiers")
- Directions and Instructions of both owner ministries (BMNT und BMASGK)
