

Sustainable Use Directive

Harmonised Risk Indicators – legal base

- Required by Article 15 (1) of Directive 2009/128
- Based on data collected under Regulation 1185/2009 and other relevant data
- Complementary to, rather than replacement for, national indicators





Harmonised Risk Indicators - Development

- Consultation with MS at Expert Group, SUD WG and Standing Committee meetings in 2018
- Standing Committee vote: 25 January 2019
- Adoption: 15 May 2019 (Dir 2019/782)
- Transposition deadline: 3 months





Harmonised Risk Indicator I

- Based on quantities of active substances in the PPPs placed on the market
- Baseline of 100 based on average 2011-2013
- 4 Categories (with different weightings)
 - Low-risk
 - Other
 - Candidates for substitution
 - Non-approved active substances





Harmonised Risk Indicator II

- Based on number of emergency authorisations
- Limited data availability = basic indicator
- Same Baseline, Categories & Weightings as HRI I





Commission obligations

- Calculate and publish EU-trend in HRI I and II 20 months after year end (30 August 2019 for 2017)
- Use the outcomes to assess progress in risk reduction





Member States obligations

- Calculate MS-trend in HRI I and II 20 months after year end (30 August 2019 for 2017)
 - (Commission facilitated MS by providing these calculations, which MS may use)
- Identify trends in certain actives (Art 15(2)(b))
- Identify priority items or good practices (Art 15(2)(c))
- Communicate the results to the Commission and make publicly available (Art 15(3))





State of play

- Commission will publish the EU-wide HRI I and II trends on the SUD web-portal
- Commission will publish links to the MS trends in HRI I and II, and the associated evaluations, on the SUD web-portal
- EU-wide HRI I and II trends will be included in the second report to the EP and Council on SUD





Next Steps

- Develop a more robust HRI II
- Consider developing a wider suite of indicators
- Refine Methodological guidance to guide MS
- SUD/Statistics WG in November to discuss issues arising/future developments etc. and opportunity to harmonise data collection on PPP use
- European Court of Auditors will publish a report on Sustainable Use of PPP
