

Operation BLACKJACK Case study from Slovakia



Criminal Office of Financial Administration

- is the only investigation body in the Slovak Republic responsible for investigation of the illegal import of goods according to Criminal Code and Criminal procedure code
- According to Section 254 Criminal Code

Breach of Regulations Governing Imports and Exports of Goods

- (1) Any person whos action gives rise to considerable endangering of public interest by breaching the prohibition or the restriction imposed on the import, export or transit of goods shall be liable to a term of imprisonment of up to two years.
- (2) Any person who by larger amount curtails the payment of or fails to pay a customs duty or other payment levied pursuant to the law on imported goods shall be liable to a term of imprisonment of between six months and three years.
- (3) The offender shall be liable to a term of imprisonment of one to five years if he commits the offence referred to in paragraphs 1 or 2 with at least two more persons.
- (4) The offender shall be liable to a term of imprisonment of three to eight years if he commits the offence referred to in paragraphs 1 or 2,
- a) and causes substantial damage or other particularly serious consequence through its commission, or,
- b) acting in a more serious manner.
- (5) The offender shall be liable to a term of imprisonment of seven to twelve years if he commits the offence referred to in paragraphs 1 or 2,
- a) and causes large-scale damage through its commission, or
- b) as a member of a dangerous grouping.



Prelude to operation

Random custom control close to the Slovak Ukrainian border in August 2018

Seizure of 200 pieces of pesticide AKTARA 0,25 lit. (rounded bottles)






Analyse of seizure

- ➤ Cooperation with Syngenta and their statement according to the BATCH No.
- ➤ Had never been imported by Syngenta Slovakia Ltd.
- ✓ One of the fine counterfeit







From august to December 2018 and still going on

- operational checkings, informators in the field of farmers and official distributors of pesticide
- > selection of suspects leaded investigation to the area close to the official distributor and importer from Ukraine
- ongoing investigation, analyses of the bank accounts and suspious bank operations
- enormus amount of bank transactions from all over the world (UAE)
- > selection places of intrests used for terminal storage of illegal pesticides before being shipped to the customer
- first evidences of illegal distribution of pesticides KRUIZER Syngenta





First period of operation

➤ Illegal subdistributors captured in december 2018 in town Michalovce (30 km from the Slovak Ukraine Border), ready for the shipment!





Galera SUPER – DowAgroSciences produced in Romania

- > not autorised in Slovak Republic, illegal import from Ukraine
- > unloaded car with 180 liters of Galera SUPER







Later garage search revealed other illegal pesticides

☐ CEZAR 1 lit. bottles – ADAMA, AKTARA 0,25 lit. bottles – SYNGENTA,

both declared being produced in Ukraine and extra Galera SUPER – DowAgroSciences produced in Romania

All of them are not autorised in Slovak Republic, illegal import from Ukraine

Summary seizure:

- ✓ Galera Super 670 litres
- ✓ AKTARA 100 litres (401 bottles per 0,25 lit)
- ✓ CEZAR 159 litres
- ✓ 929 litres
- ✓ And cigaretes JIN LING also.




Close ups – squared bottle unlike the first seizure rounded bottle






Interogation of captured subdistributor (Ukrainian citizen – deportated from the Slovak Republic in the year 2008 for a three years, now captured with changed first and last name) leaded to futher revelation that had been confirmed by another garage search with another illegal and unautorised pesticides


- ☐ MOSPILAN 130 packs 1 kg each and another evidence
- ☐ Some packs with product label MOSPILAN some without
- ☐ Extra product labels yet not sticked on
- ☐ Measuring cups of other products like TITUS (herbicide) and GRANSTAR PRO (herbicide)













Once there has not been proved breaching of Regulations Governing Imports of pesticides according to section 254 Criminal Code our investigation is being passed to the Police of the Slovak Republic that would qualify it (according to the Crime Code) as

Endangering and Damaging the Environment Section 300

- (1) Any person who wilfully creates the danger of smaller environmental damage by violating generally binding legal environmental protection regulations or the rules of protection and management of natural resources including natural healing resources and natural resources of mineral table water shall be liable to a term of imprisonment of up to three years.
- (4) The offender shall be liable to a term of imprisonment of three to eight years if he commits the offence referred to in paragraph 1, and causes substantial environmental damage through its commission.
- (5) The offender shall be liable to a term of imprisonment of four to ten years if he commits the offence referred to in paragraph 1, and causes large-scale environmental damage through its commission.

Bus line Mukacevo - Košice

- bus SETRA S215HD with built in toilet entering SR on 22th july 2019
- ▶ illegal import of pesticides in toilet bin, acces to sink from the trunk of the bus

- Granstar Pro 1 kg
- Impakt 5 litres
- Aktara 10 litres
- Capylso 6 litres
- Kruyzer 35 litres
- Coragen 10 litres

- Kerti Zoldség trágya 8 kg
- Mospilan 50 kg
- Sanmadt z.p. 5 kg
- Nurelle D 80 litres

Seizure of Ilegal (fake) pesticides in Kosice

On 16th of july 2019 - Moldova car Mercedes Benz - with Romanian citizen

- ✓ Carried 50 litres of pestcides CORAGEN 20 SC (produced by DUPONT)
- ✓ Hungarian labels
- ✓ Fake product






Seizure of Ilegal pesticides close to Kosice

On 24th of june 2019 - Slovak citizen in private car

- ✓ Carried 80 litres of pestcides Galera Super (produced by DowAgro Sciences)
- ✓ English and Romanian labels
- ✓ Original product





Ilegal import of pesticides Slovak Ukraine border

On 6th of september 2019 - Ukrainian citizen (driver of lorry)

- ✓ Carried 40 litres of pestcides Coragen 20 SC 10 liters and Kruyzer 30 liters
- ✓ Russian labels
- ✓ Original products
